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Monferrato DOC Nebbiolo

Color

Ruby red with garnet reflections.

Aroma

Lightly floral aromas with notes of plum and berry fruit balanced by savoury characters.

Palate

The palate is juicy with ripe plum and black cherry, supple tannins and a lightly spicy finish.

Grape variety

Nebbiolo

Area

Monferrato hills in Piemonte. South West aspects at altitudes between 250 and 400m. Limestone-clay soil.

Vineyards

Piemonte low Guyot trellis. Planting density 4,000 - 4,500 vines/ha.

Food Match

Pasta with meat sauces, boiled or marinated meats, medium-aged cheeses.
